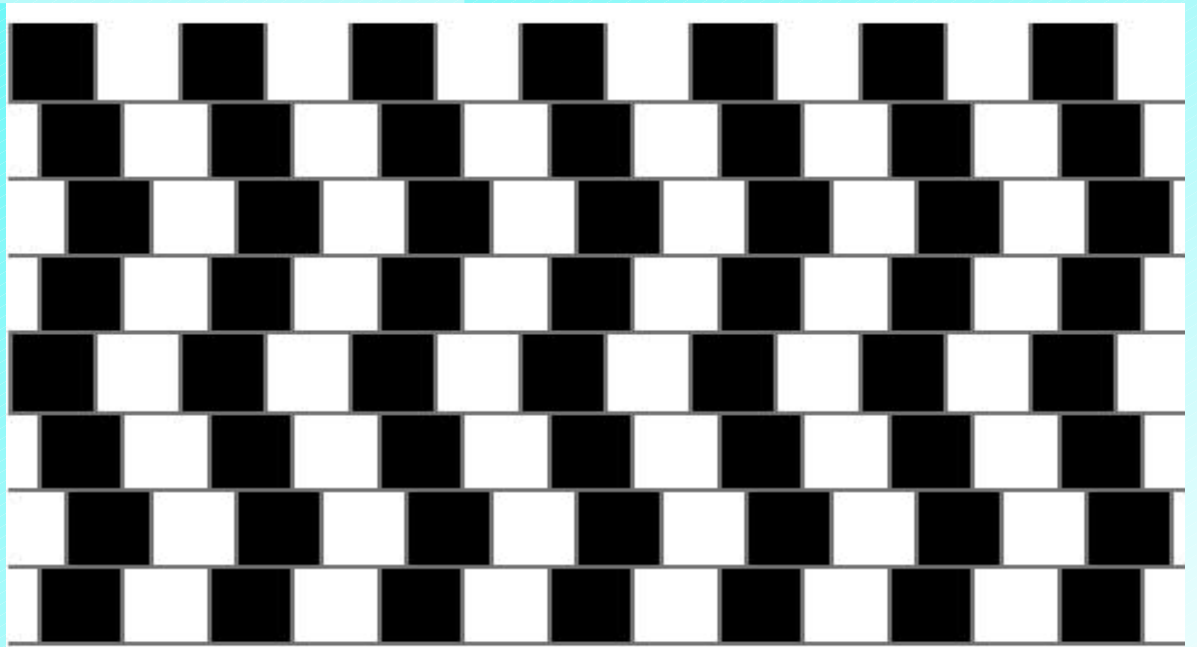
Young lady or old?

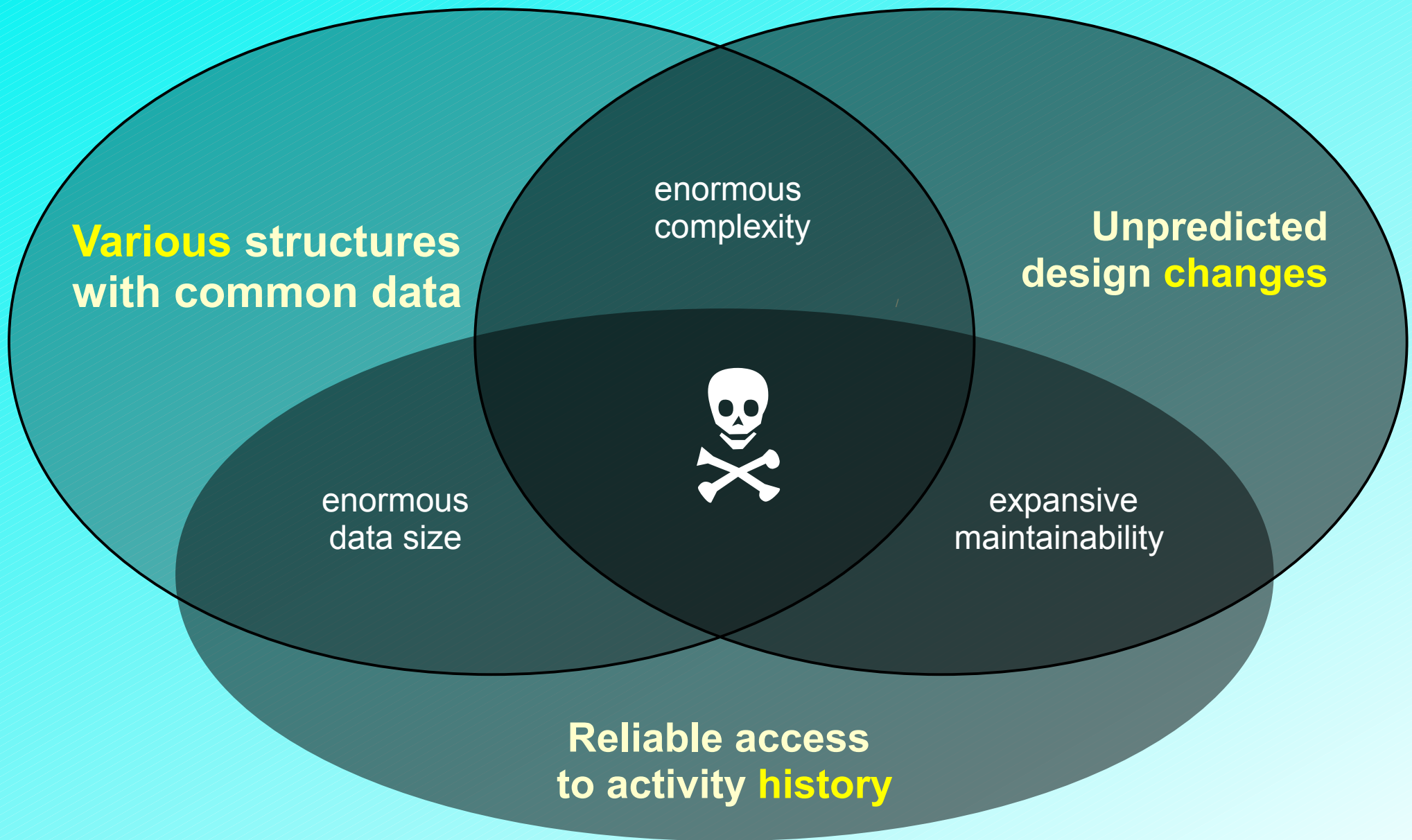

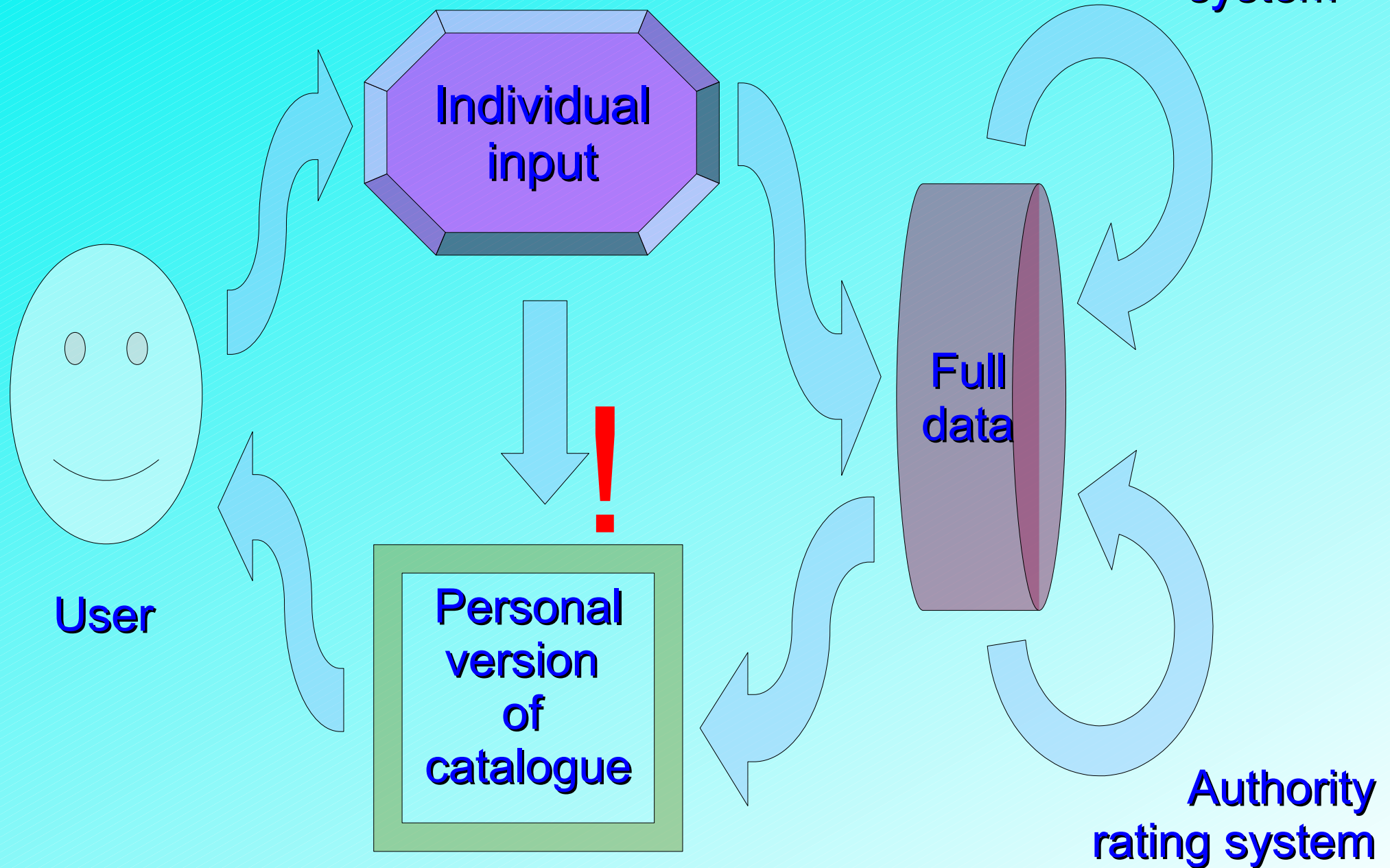

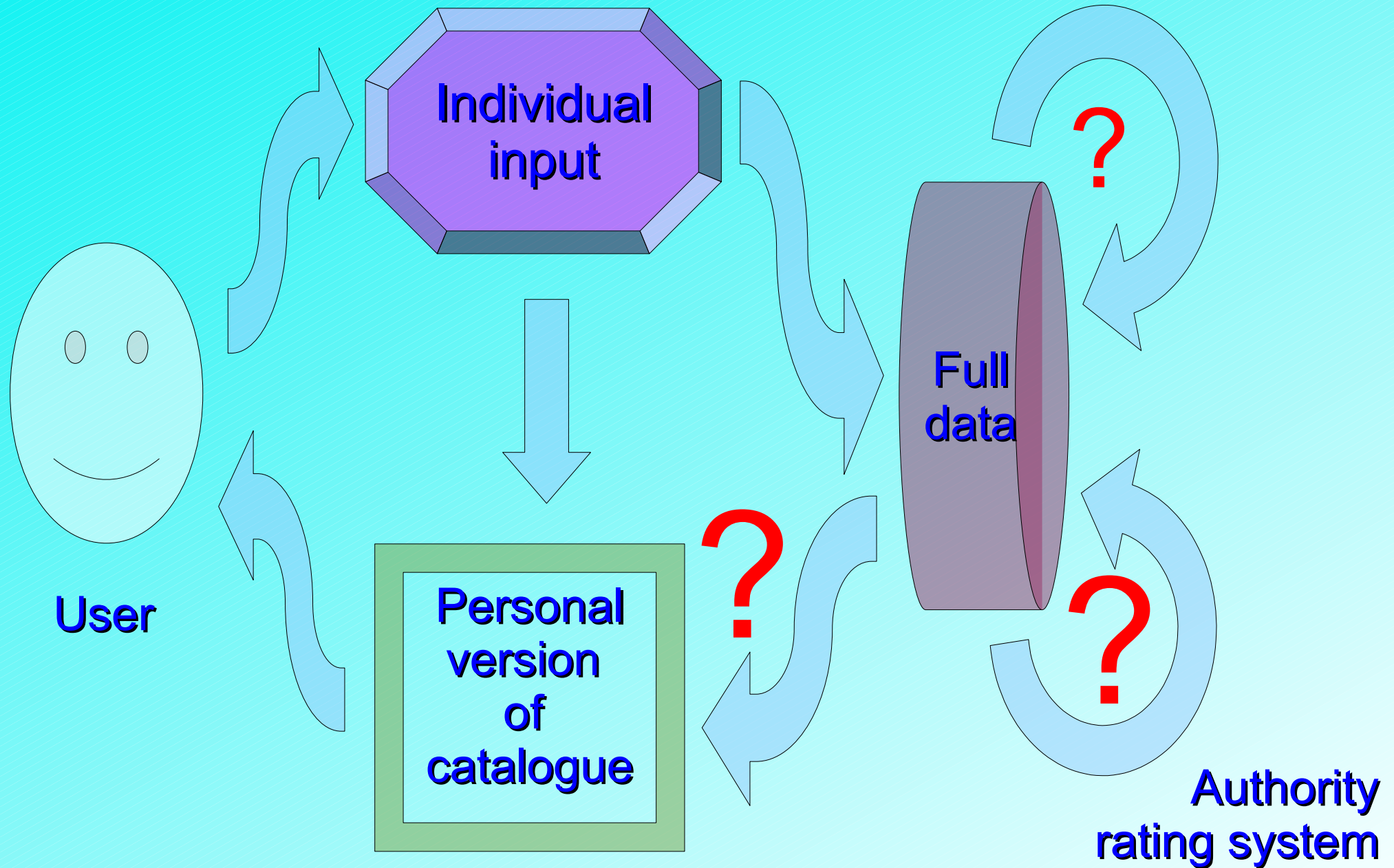
